Board of Director's Meeting Minutes June 23, 2007

Meeting called to order at 11:00am at the corporate address: 301 Centennial Blvd Richardson, TX 75081.

Routine Business

Approval of May 12, 2007 minutes Michael Peavy moved that the minutes be approved. Passed 5-0-0.

Monthly Update: BOD correspondence (A. Jacobs). Michael Peavy advised that the letter sent to Zach Pool had been returned unclaimed. Jason Jacobs moved that the BOD write a letter to Mrs. L. Hurst for her gracious donation of a binding machine and binding materials. Passed 5-0-0.

Update: Petitioning/Interested Parks (Rodas). Jorge Rodas advised the Board that he will be asking Richard

Lawrence if Mr. Rodas can be an appointed liaison to continue working with petitioning and interested parks. Newsletter of t

Storm Grove and Riverstone ~ will sign petitioning contracts with the Emerald Hills at the event (next weekend).

King's Point (Hurst, Texas) ~ the park's leadership has not yet decided whether to petition the Emerald Hills. Jorge Rodas will update as he has more information.

Souls' Crossing ~ Possibility of signing petitioning contract with the Emerald Hills at the event (next weekend).

Stonebriar (Plano, Texas) ~ On hold.

Mystic Mountains ~ Strongdrake confirmed that he is still in possession of assets of Tal Dagore. Andréa Jacobs suggested that the Emerald Hills should not enter into a contract with the Mystic Mountains until the Tal Dagore corporate assets are properly distributed. Jorge Rodas agreed. No Board action taken as it is the Monarch (Mr. Jorge Rodas) who decides what parks may petition the Emerald Hills.

Old Business

Update: Collecting new park contracts. (Board)

We received Eagleshire's contract.

Update: Termination of Midnight Rain Petitioning Contract (A.

Jacobs)

Midnight Rain has requested that their contract not be terminated. Andréa Jacobs confirms that she, as Kingdom Prime Minister, can now access the Midnight Rain ORK. Andréa Jacobs confirmed that the termination letter had not yet been sent due to (1) no address was on file and (2) the request to not be terminated. John Elder moved to rescind the Board's previous decision to terminate the contract. Passed 6-0-0.

Discussion: Kingdom Fundraising Ideas (A. Jacobs/Rodas) Andréa Jacobs and Jorge Rodas suggested using the recently donated binding machine to make cookbooks and archival collections for sale to benefit the Emerald Hills. Andréa Jacobs is interested in creating a "Booster Club" that is separate from the Emerald Hills so that any fundraising done does not place an additional burden on the Emerald Hills' Treasurer. She will research the issue and make sure it is legal and properly set up.

Getting merchants to the events was discussed. Andréa Jacobs suggested some form of currency exchange that could be used for merchants, food, beverages, etc. Kevin Kidwell advised that actual Emerald Hills' currency would be too expensive to maintain. Tokens and paper money would be too easy to counterfeit. No Board action taken.

Discussion: "Road to 501(c)(3) status" (A. Jacobs) Andréa Jacobs re-opened discussions regarding the process to get 501(c)(3) status by suggesting that the Emerald Hills begin emphasizing the workshops at events more. Promoting the educational aspects of Amtgard is important if we are striving for an educational exemption. No Board action taken.

Update: Letter for RGK

Andréa Jacobs has prepared the letter for Ms. Tuscana and will deliver it to her at the next event (next weekend).

New Business

Clarification: Implementation of Dues Increase (A. Jacobs/J.

The dues increase was effective immediately because there was no effective date posted on item submitted to the Althing.

Storage Shed

John Elder suggested to not renew our contract with the storage facility currently used to store records and property and find another facility. The current facility is difficult to find; rarely used; and out of the way. John Elder suggested a facility near our corporate address. Michael Peavy suggested a facility near the I-635 and I-35E interchange so that it was more centrally located. Andréa Jacobs moved that a new storage facility be found but that the location should be decided at the next meeting. Passed 6-0-0.
