I have a number of items that I would like to discuss:

- 1. ORK. All of the parks with the exception of Bifost have ORK access at this point. I believe that this is a major step forward, as centralized record keeping is definitely preferable to a mismatch of databases and hidden caches of file folders. Some of you might recall that I had announced an audit at mid-reign. Unfortunately, fully implementing ORK took longer than I initially anticipated, so we did not have time to begin the audit. I am therefore forced to leave that project to who ever succeeds me.
- 2. The Star. This has to be one of the leanest Stars I can remember. I cannot stress enough the importance of submitting content. Without actual submissions, we will not have very much beyond letters from our officers and the BoD minutes going to print. So, if you write anything Amtgard related like poetry or prose for qualifications please, please, please send it in. I would be more than happy to include it. Drawings are good too by the way. Feel free to send those in as well.
- 3. Copies of the 7th Ed Rulebook. At the request of the monarch, I have not printed out any copies of the 7th edition rules. The circle of Monarchs had a meeting at the Gathering of the Clans to vote on a number of clarifications. It seemed pretty pointless to spend money printing out less than complete copies of the rules.
- 4, Speaking of money, part 1 Last Althing we voted to set aside \$600 for printing new copies of the rulebook. The very next day, when the BoD met to discuss finances it became apparent that our kingdom is less than flush with cash. We have a little over \$3000 in the bank. The \$600 we had set aside will have to come out of that money leaving us a about \$2400 or so to front Spring War. As an aside I intend to bring this expenditure up at the Althing, given this revelation I would very much like to see this proposal voted on again before spending any money.
- 5. Speaking of money, part 2 Gate Crashing. I am going to bring this up here, because I know that many of you will not read through the BoD minutes. Gate Crashing has become a serious problem of late. A number of people have either slipped by, or even worse stopped to accost the Gate crew. This isn't going to be tolerated any longer. Crashing gate is outright theft of services. Our kingdom doesn't charge gate to cover feast, we charge gate to cover the cost of the site. Arguing that you won't be eating feast, does not in any way, shape or form negate

the fact you will be making use of the site. So, please pay your gate fees, your kingdom could use the money, the people running gate don't need the abuse and the BoD doesn't need the business. Clear enough?

- 6. Other official business. In addition to holding the office of Prime Minister, I am also this reign's Guild Master of Scouts and it is that capacity that I would like to make an the following announcement. I would like to recognize Shaggy, for his excellent portrayal of our class. Shaggy has been playing Scout for as long as I can recall knowing him. Good Job, Shaggy. Ween, consider this acknowledgement my recommendation for his masterhood.
- 7. So long and thanks for all the Fish. I would like to thank everyone who has worked with me this reign. It has not been an easy process to transition to ORK. In particular I would like to thank the following individuals for being early adopters and real troopers in bringing their parks up to speed, Bromhir, Katiana, Son of Midnight, and Wynde. Most of all I would like to thank my wife, Selene for helping me edit these Stars, maintaining our Kingdom's website and generally putting up with me. She has been a great help. I could not have done it with out her.

Regarding CK-Amtgard List Moderation

For the past six or so months, I have been moderating the list mostly to prevent traffic other than announcements from being posted. A number of complaints and concerns have been brought to my attention during that time. The most relevant include concerns that it takes too long for a message to be approved, and that since everyone doesn't have access to the forums denying discussion based messages is unfair.

Both concerns have merits. It is true that it sometimes takes a long time for me to review messages. Most of our moderators are less than active these days, and with my lack of internet access at work it can sometimes take me several days to review a given post. Simply promoting more people to the post of moderator isn't exactly a good solution either as there isn't always a clear consensus as to what makes an appropriate post.

As to fairness, it is common knowledge that the email lists are more widely viewed than the forums. Not everyone has access either due to ban, or technological difficulties with their system. Also since the forums are not moderated at all, there seems little point in my mind to moderate the list. Anyone with an account on the forums can say what ever they like, however inflammatory or malign. It seems to me that continuing to moderate one and not the other doesn't seem especially fair.

So as of today, I am pulling moderation from the CK email list. I believe that we should collectively talk about what sort of standards if any we want upheld on our Kingdom's internet forums at the next Althing. If there is to be moderation, then let it is apply to all of our resources and let the measure pass a formal vote.

Celestial Kingdom Board of Directors Meeting, May 15th, 2005

The May 15th 2005 meeting of the Celestial Kingdom Board of Directors was held at Camp Ben McCoulough, at 11:25 am. The president Mistie Brown called the meeting order and role was taken. All seven members of the board of directors were present and a quorum was established. The floor was opened for old business.

The floor was opened for old business.

Item 1 Central Texas Kingdom (CTK) Insurance policy. Our insurance provider needs each province to have valid contracts on file with the Burning Lands Board of Directors. At present only four of the CK provinces have contracts on file. Theo may have copies of the original contracts but newly formed provinces will need to file as soon as possible.

Item 2 Notary Certification for Mistie Brown. Mistie Brown proposed that the CK pay for her Notary certification so that she can notorize documents for the CK in general and for the three member kingdoms of the CTK in particular for the next four years. Motion was seconded by Brad Woodruff and passed 7-0.

Item 3 Spring War Finances. Michelle Lurker presented the Board of Directors with the 05' Spring War finance summary. The kingdom lost money on the event (see separate financial statement). The most significant reason for the loss was the lack of a written contract on the site which meant that we had to re-negotiate rates with the owner and manager after the fact. We also lost money on t-shirts having spent \$986 in production while selling only \$227 worth of shirts. Other significant losses which could have been avoided included the rental of a wood splitter, and an extra golf cart rental that ended up being used by an individual.

Item 4: Regarding Wendell Johnston: He has satisfied the terms of their community service commitment and are released by the BoD. Also Wendell has paid in full the debt he owed from the "slave auction" fundraiser.

Item 4 Coronation Finances. Kristin Seigrist presented the coronation finance report. The Kingdom's initial output towards the event was \$650. We took \$1140 in gate, however we had a total of \$600 in tent fees which amounted to a net loss of \$XXX.XX. There seemed to be some disagreement between Camp Ben McColough officials and our autocrat on how many tents were onsite, and how many of our members slept in their cars. Note, if park officials even believe you are sleeping in your car they will charge the Kingdom the full amount as though you had camped.

Item 5 William Winnie's (Kaderian) Charge of Libel against Ben Pomerantz (Clalibus). William Winnie submitted a formal complaint before the BoD regarding several posts made by Ben Pomerantz on the CK's email list. The BoD voted unanimously 7-0 to hear the complaint in a formal hearing to occur sometime in early June.

New Business:

Item 1 Installation of New Members. Michelle Lurker, Mistie Brown, Doug Beddingfeild, and Ryan Christian stepped up as members of the BoD.

Item 2 Dismissal of Old Members. Kristin Siegrest was thanked for her service and dismissed, Michelle Lurker was also thanked and dismissed from her original term. However as monarch she continues to hold a seat on the Board.

Item 3 Election of Officers. Ryan Christian was elected Treasurer (Ryan received 4 votes, Brad I, and Mistie 2) Mistie Brown was elected President (Mistie received 5 votes, and Doug 2). Michelle Lurker was elected Member's Officer (She received 5 votes to Doug's 2).

Item 4 Gate Runners. There has been an ongoing issue with people continually running gate either by simply driving through or else bullying their way past the gate crew. This will no longer be tolerated. The BoD voted 7-0 to take action against this sort of behavior in the future. Running gate is theft of services, and will be treated as such by the BoD. Only a very small portion of our gate fees are for feast or other luxuries, the vast majority of that fee covers paying for the site. Since everyone present makes use of the site, there is no room for negotiation as to what the cost is to participate.

Item 5 Kingdom Fundraisers. Kristin Siegrist requested and was granted permission to hold fundraisers in the Kingdom's name for the next six months. The measure passed 6-1.

Entering Records into **ORK** By Rand - CK PM

1. Log in as Local Chancellor.

2. Managing Players:

- a. To find an existing player go the player list under PM controls, it's the third option on the left.
- b. To enter a new player click on the "add new player" button, at the top left under player list. When adding new players please enter as much mundane information as possible, also note if they are dues paid and when their dues expire.
- c. To transfer a player to another park, click on the their name under player list, then go player information. There is a drop down menu for current chapter. Select the player's new chapter and then click on apply changes.
- d. If you need to delete an erroneous record, you will find the "delete" command just below the drop down menu for the current chapter.

3. Updating Individual Weeks (and tracking class levels)

- a. Weeks are added by first accessing a given player record then clicking on the box labeled "view credits". New classes are added by selecting the applied to drop down menu and choose the appropriate class. You can then select the value of weeks to be applied, and finally the province in which they were acquired. The date the credit was acquired can be modified via a series of drop down menus entitled "credit date" in the upper right hand corner of your screen.
- b. Existing classes are listed under the player's name in the split below the "add credit to <insert player name here> screen. To add a credit to a class that already is in use simply click on the name of the class to modify. Then choose the value of said credit and their source as described above.
- c. To leave the weeks screen at any time simply click on the "view player" button to the left of the screen.
- 4. Adding Titles (Lord / Lady, Barons, Counts, various shades of Dukes)
- a. Access the player record as described in step 2.
- b. Click on the "add title" button listed under "player info"
- c. You will need to enter the title to be added, the name of the person who bestowed the title, and the date upon which the title was given.
- d. Click on "add this title"
- e. Click on the "cancel" button in the upper right hand corner to go back to the main menu.
- f. Please see the section X for additional information on **ORK** etiquette.

- 5. Adding Awards (Roses, Owls, Warriors, Griffons, ect)
- a. Access the player record as described in step 2.
- b. Cick on the "add award" button listed under "add title".
- c. You will need to select the name of the award to add in the "award" drop down menu, then the name of the officer who gave the award as well as the date the award was given.
- d. Click on the "add this award" button.
- g. Click on the "cancel" button in the upper right hand corner to go back to the main menu.
- h. Please see the section X for additional information on **ORK** etiquette.

6. Adding Positions (Local and Kingdom level offices)

- a. Access the player record as described in step 2.
- b. Cick on the "add position" button to the right of "add title".
- c. You will need to enter the position held and what level then select the date of the player's term of office from the drop down menu.
- d. Click on the "add this position" button.
- e. Click on the "cancel" button in the upper right hand corner to go back to the main menu.
- f. Please see the section X for additional information on **ORK** etiquette.

7. Adding Groups (Households, and Companies)

- a. Access the player record as described in step 2.
- b. Click on the "add group" button listed under "add position"
- c. You will need to enter the name of the group the player belongs to and any position they might hold. For example, "Captain of the Golden Lions".
- d. Click on "add this group"
- e. Click on the "cancel" button in the upper right hand corner to go back to the main menu.
- f. Please see the section X for additional information on **ORK** etiquette.
- 8. Adding Masterhoods (Warlord, Master Rose, Master Dragon, ect.)
- a. Access the player record as described in step 2.
- b. Click on the "add masterhood" button listed under "full printed record button" in the top left hand corner of the screen.
- c. You will need to enter the granted masterhood, the name of the person officer who awarded it, and the date upon which the masterhood was given.
- d. Click on "add this masterhood"
- e. Click on the "cancel" button in the upper right hand corner to go back to the main menu.
- f. Please see the section X for additional information on **ORK** etiquette.

- 9. Adding Misc. Information (original or alternate persona names, as well as titles that are no longer held, such as squires who have been since raised to knighthood).
- a. Access the player record as described in step 2.
- b. Click on the "add misc" button listed under "add masterhood"
- c. You will need to enter the misc information in the space provided.
- d. Click on "add this misc"
- e. Click on the "cancel" button in the upper right hand corner to go back to the main menu.
- f. Please see the section X for additional information on **ORK** etiquette.
- 10. How to print a given player record.
- a. Access the player record as described in step 2.
- b. Click on the "full printed record" button in the top right most corner.
- II. How to make a player "inactive." At the local chancellors discretion they can make a given player's account inactive, meaning it will not be displayed on the **ORK** website, include the player on the group access options, or appear under any of the reports.
- a. Select the player to be made inactive from the player list under PM controls; it is the third option on the left.
- b. Go player information. There is a check box labeled "activity" right after "waiver on file" on the lower right hand side of the screen. Simply uncheck the box.
- c. Click on "apply changes"
- d. To leave the submenu at any time click on "cancel"
- e. Obviously to make a player active again, all you have to do is check the box, and then save the changes.
- 12. Updating multiple week record (Useful for entering in whole sign ins sheets at time).
- a. Go to "add daily credits" link under PM controls on the left hand side of the screen.
- b. Select the player record in question from the "player" drop down menu.
- c. Select the class they would like the credit applied to from "select class" menu.
- d. Select the value for the credit, under the next drop down menu.
- e. Select the province the credit was acquired in from the last menu.
- f. If you need to spot check or delete a credit all of the credits added that day will appear in the split screen below these options.
- 13. Adding Out of Kingdom Visitor Credits (In kingdom visitors can have their province selected from the drop down menu.)


- a. Go to "add visitor credits link" under PM controls on the left hand side of the screen.
- b. You will need to manually type in the player's name, and the abbreviation from their home kingdom. Then select the class and value of the credit from the drop down menu.
- 14. Reports (ORK has a number of reporting options and filters available).
- a. All reporting options can be found on the left hand side of the screen under the "Reports" section.
- b. "Total credits" report gives a break down of each player's classes and total number of weeks in each. It can be filtered via active, inactive or both, by selecting the desired option from the "showing players that are" drop down menu on the right hand side.
- c. "Soon to level" report lists each active player that is a week or two away from achieving the next level in a given class.
- d. "Undeclared" credits report lists individuals who have credit values with out an associated class.
- e. "Award Summary" report gives a break down of each active player's awards by both category and number.
- f. "Attendance" report allows the chancellor to see how many credits were earned on what day by a series of drop down menus for start and end dates. It also differentiates between park members and visitors.
- g. "Vistiors" report allows the chancellor to see how many players from another province attended the park in a given time frame. As with attendance, this is accomplished by a series of drop down menus encompassing a start and end date.
- h. "Voting Eligibility". As I mentioned early there is a field under "player information" to record how long a given player is dues paid. This report filters that information and allows the local officers to see who is eligible to vote. This is also accomplished by sorting start and end dates via drop down menu.
- i. "Contact list" With **ORK** there isn't a need for any more Amtgard Directories. The contact list report will generate a complete list of persona names, mundane names, phone numbers, email addresses and dates of birth for each active member.
- j. "Sign in sheet", generates a list of all the active native members of the province, as well as a list of their classes and the number of credits they have acquired in each. All they need do is write this weeks class in the open space to the left of their name. Visitors have their own blank spaces to record their presence.
- k. Printed copies of any of these reports are readily generated by clicking on the "printable version" button at the top of the list of players.
- 15. Herald Controls (Or save your devices on line.)
- a. Simply click on the "player heraldry" link on the left hand side of the screen.

- b. Choose the active player whose heraldry you would like to record. c. Copy and paste either the heraldry URL or the photo URL into the space provided.
- d. Suggest size is 150 pixels by 150 pixels.
- e. Click on the "update heraldry for player" button.

16. Logging out is accomplished by clicking on the "log out" button on the very bottom of the list on the left hand side of the page.

17. ORK Etiquette (Or more information is better than just today's date.)

- a. If you don't remember the name of the officer who gave you that award seven years ago, at least put the office they held. For Example: Lion #1 Given by the Duchy of Traitor's Gate. Or Knight of the Crown, given by the Burning Lands. b. If you know the person's name, please include their title at the time they gave you
- b. If you know the person's name, please include their title at the time they gave you the award. I generally use the abbreviation HRH for his or her royal highness if the monarch gave the award. For example HRH Hulka, HRH Ween.
- c. If you don't remember the exact date then guess which reign it fell under either Spring / Summer (May to October) or Fall / Winter (November to April).
 d. It is expected that newer awards will have more accurate information as to who gave an award and when it was given. For example, a player may not remember who gave him his first three owls, but when they are awarded their fourth all of the information needs to be recorded in **ORK**.
- e. Going to the **ORK** standard doesn't absolve individual members from keeping paper records. Please keep your awards in case there is ever a question.
- f. Please don't uncheck the box labeled, allow Kingdom PM access. For obvious reasons I need access to the provinces to do my job.
- g. Please don't change your assigned password; I might need to give it to your successor.
