
From the Crown



From Austin and points east take US 183 north out of Austin, turn left on Tx 29 drive to Burnet, take a left on US 281 in Burnet drive about a mile and turn right into the fairgrounds. From Killeen and Points North Take US 190 west to US 281, turn left and take 281 south through Burnet and turn right into the fairgrounds about a mile past the intersection of US 281 and Tx 29. 
