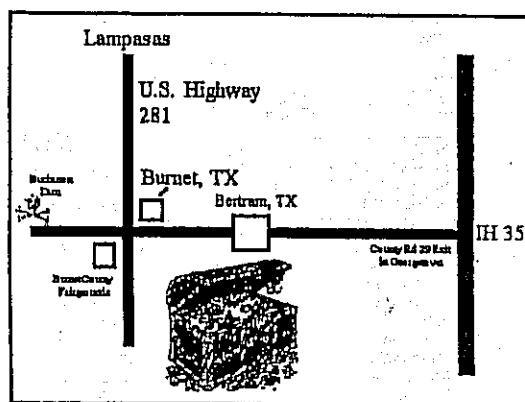

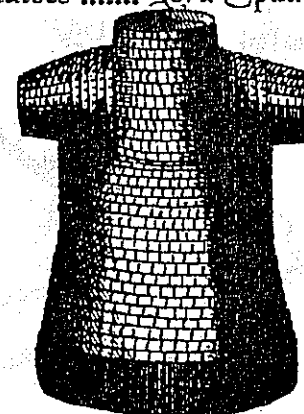

A Letter from the Prime Minister

Greetings... and welcome to my second Star! This is our special Kingdom Elections/War issue! We expect to have a record attendance for the war/coronation. It is also one of the cheapest events we have ever had. Site and feast for only \$5! Who can't afford that?

By the time you read this, we will be preparing the the Kingdom Allthing. Many people don't realize how important the Allthing is to our democratic process. We need to make a very important decision in this Allthing. Do we adopt the new Sixth Edition rules, or do we continue to play with the Fifth Edition rules. This is very important because it affects how we interact with other groups. I have heard many comments, some good, some bad, about the Sixth Edition and it is time to decide.

I am also rather disappointed in how few other requests were submitted for the Allthing. A number of people said that they wanted to put something in there, but when told they actually had to write it down and submit it, they lost interest. Please think about this the next time you are complaining about a rule you don't like, or are wondering why something isn't in the Corpora, but should be. We can't change things for the better unless someone gives us a clue as to what they would like to change.

Kingdom elections promise to be hot and heavy. We have three good qualified candidates running for King, all of whom would make an excellent King. I have happily watched the candidates campaigning in the various groups. It is good to see these people want to help the group badly enough to campaign rigourously. It also should be noted that only about 10 percent of the people who come out and play every weekend are paid members. Remember that if you plan on sending a proxy vote in, you must be registered in my list BEFORE the event. I cannot accept proxy votes for unpaid members at the event, even if you have their payment there with you.

I also have some important news for those of you who have been requesting our Non-profit Number. The bad news is that we don't really have one. I have done some research with the IRS and they have nothing on us in their computer. All we have is an EIN (Employer Identification Number). Anyone who is using this number to buy things without sales tax should stop, it could get us into trouble. In order to become a Non-profit organization in the eyes of the IRS we must file a Request for Determination form (1024). The processing fee for this form is \$150. Our understanding is that it is extremely difficult to obtain this status. And we still have to pay whether it is approved or not. We are going to allow the Allthing to decide whether or not we should pursue this. At the very least, we could not pursue this until after Kingdom Coronation. That would mean it could not be completed during my term of office. I am still debating whether or not I should run again for Prime Minister, since I am considering running for King in the next elections. Anyone with opinions on this are welcome to talk to me.

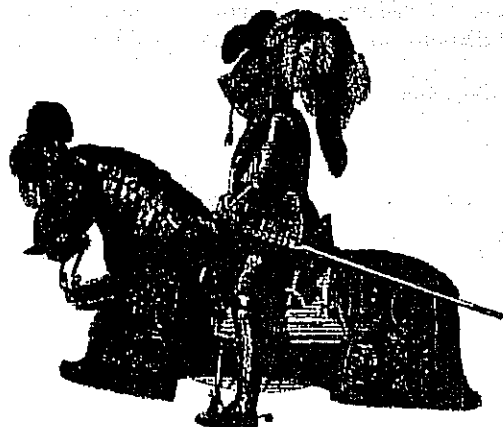
We've gained another barony during this reign, we've proved our mettle in a war, and we've managed, I think, to keep the Kingdom running smoothly.

CELESTIAL KINGDOM QUALIFICATIONS AND ROYAL ELECTIONS

Crown tournament will be held as planned on February 13th in the Barony of Bifost. To get the park come into Kerrville on 111 10 form the East. Use exit 505 and take a left into town. Drive about two miles on that road which becomes Harper street. Take a right on Lois and drive 2 blocks to the Park which is on the left hand side of the road.

All candidates for Monarch or Regent must declare their intent to run in writing to either me or Prime Minister Fnord. One of us must have the declaration by February 1st, 1994.

The cultural tournament will be run by Regent Mandrake rules are as follows:

- 1) Entries may not have been entered in other Amtgard tournaments.
- 2) All entries must have been finished within the last six months
- 3) No entries may have previously received an award.
- 4) If assistance is received for more than 1/4 of the total effort then the assistant must be listed as a co-entrant. Failure to do this can result in both parties being totally disqualified.
- 5) All entries will be judged blind with only a number identifying them.
- 6) All entries judged on a 5 point scale.

Proxies:

Since not all of us can always get Sundays off a proxy system is essential. However since we have had cases of proxies being used in an attempt to fix an election in the past, I am enforcing the following restrictions on proxies. Proxies will be accepted only by myself and Prime Minister Fnord and only on the day of the tournament. Proxies must be signed with both mundane and persona names. Any member voting by proxy must have his or her dues paid up at the kingdom level by the week before the tournament. That is no proxies will be accepted with an enclosed dollar. Payment at the time of the vote will be accepted from voters who are present at the event. If you want to make sure your proxy will be accepted, then make sure that Prime Minister Fnord has your dues status updated before you turn in a proxy. Local Chancellors should take note that if they fail to keep Fnord informed of their people's dues status, it will be their fault if their people can not vote by proxy.

Don Perimone/Therion

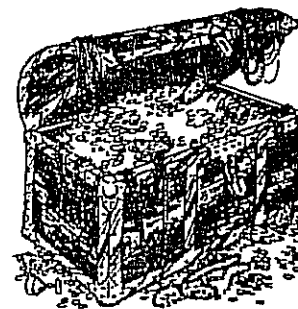
I would like to announce my intent to run for King of the Celestial Kingdom. I believe myself to be the best candidate, out of those I know are running, for several reasons.

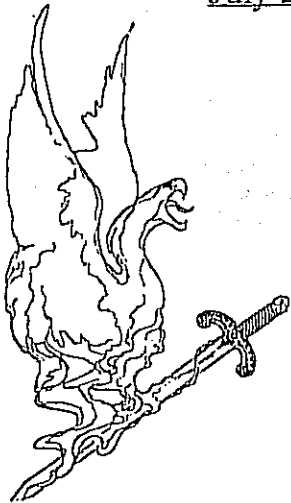

But the road, the man does make.

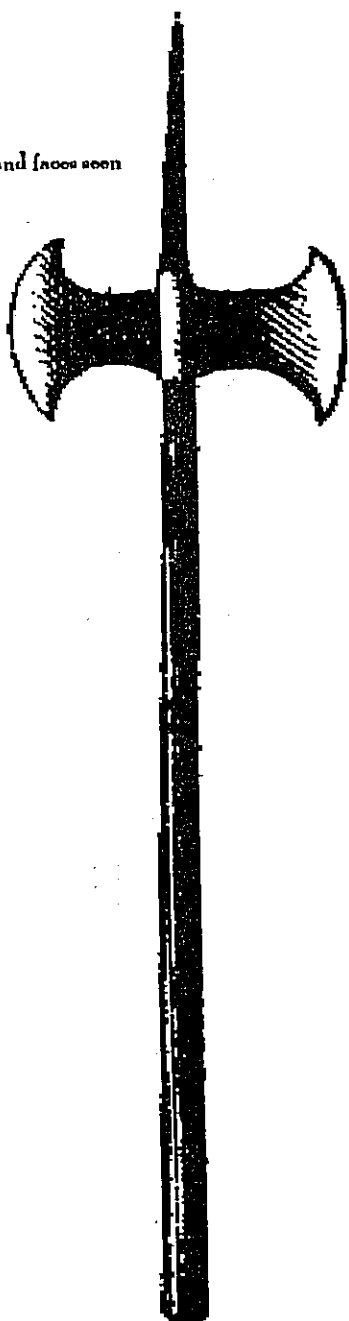

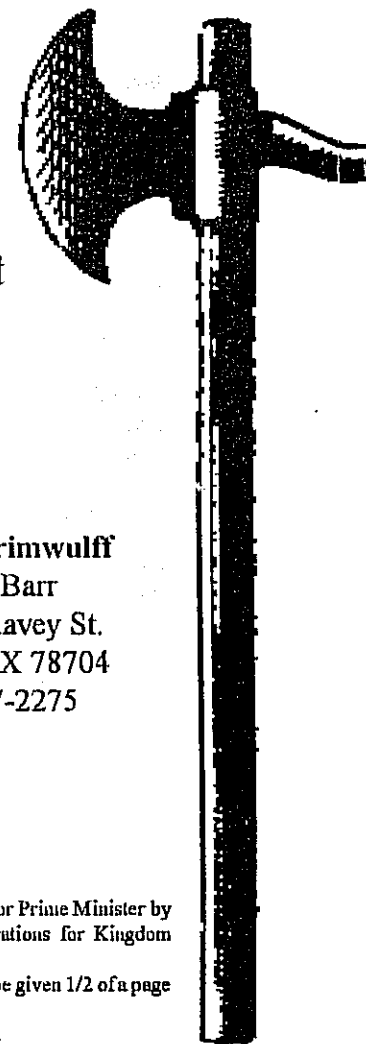

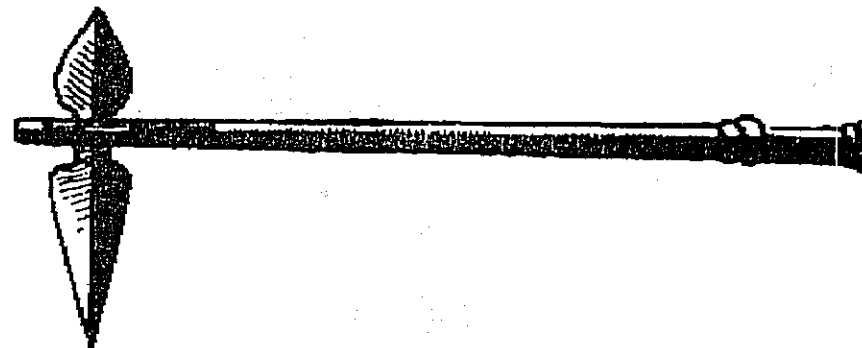
