ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

AMTGARD, KINGDOM OF THE EMERALD HILLS A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 1396-3.02 of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act (Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes) the undersigned incorporator(s), in order to form a non-profit corporation under the laws of the state of TEXAS, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE: The name of this corporation is AMTGARD, KINGDOM OF THE EMERALD HILLS.

ARTICLE TWO: The name of the registered agent and the address of the registered office of this corporation are:

ARTICLE THREE: The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are: AMTGARD, KINGDOM OF THE EMERALD HILLS IS A GROUP OF PEOPLE DEDICATED TO THE STUDY AND RECREATION OF THE MEDIEVAL ERA AND THE FANTASY AND/OR HISTORICAL LITERATURE GENRE.

This corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE SIX: THE PERIOD OF DURATION OF THIS CORPORATION IS PERPETUAL.

ARTICLE SEVEN: The classes, rights, privileges, qualifications, and obligations of members of this corporation are as follows:

This corporation shall have one class of membership. Any person shall be qualified to become a member upon payment of the initial dues, and shall continue as a member upon paying the semiannual dues. The method and time of payment of dues shall be determined, by the Bylaws of this corporation. Additional provisions specifying the rights and obligations of members shall be contained in the Bylaws of this corporation pursuant to, and in accordance with, the laws of this state.

ARTICLE EIGHT: Any additional provisions for the operation of the corporation are as follows:

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of ARTICLE 6.02(3) OF THE TEXAS NON-PROFIT CORPORATION ACT, AND Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services

rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code. In any taxable year in which this corporation is a private foundation as described in Section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, the corporation 1) shall distribute its income for said period at such time and manner as not to subject it to tax under Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code; 2) shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code; 3) shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code; 4) shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code; and 5) shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code.


